3. SeaKing –Pat McCarthy is the new rep on WIAA board for District 2, District 2 director, and SPD athletic director. Three positions up for exec board-district 4,5, 6. New district 3: Dwayne Johnson, Tony Davis. Up for vote District 2, 8, 9 next year.
4. WIAA Report – Going back to pre-practice requirements for fall. Waivers are going away by end of July. E sports info TBD.

Governance committee- 4 recommendations:

- Redistrict WIAA, by combining. Combine 5 and 6 to 5. Combine 7-9, and to District 6. Allows for multi classification leagues, helps with transportation
- Different format for bracketing: League keeps allocation, no longer with district. Enables path to playoffs in your own league-this will be an early amendment in January rep assembly.
- Adjust WIAA exec board to align with re districting, so 6 instead of 9. The open 3 spots move toward 2nd region spot (eastern Washington). Concern about E. Washington unique needs have not been heard.
- Common expectations for each district (common practices, consistency with WIAA eligibility rules, site selection procedures, accounting procedures)

Had first reading on allocations, will be on WSSAA Wednesday.

5. WSSAAA – Lance G and Cathy Schick recognized at WSSAA conference as AD of the year for District 2.
6. Classification Meeting Reports – 2A Bi-District Agreement. Lori meeting with Dixon and Dwayne Johnson. All team sports by seeding committee (AD's league presidents, coaches) 2A will need to meet about this.

4A -john A sent out bi-district agreement, waiting to hear from WIAA on allocations for this year.

Additional Items:

- President-Elect: Kingco has nominated Wes Newton for 2022-23 year. Leadership team as follows:
 - Lori Box (2021-22 President)
 - Dan Pudwill (past 2020-21 president)
 - Jesse Snyder (past 19-20 president)
- Sea-King Rep: As president elect, Wes cannot be Sea-King rep. Send nominations to Dan Pudwill.
- Handbook changes (Dan): stipend language: league dues need to be modified to reflect the number of schools now at 24. Or just modify to say \$500 per school, so as to not keep changing if league size changes again. Does not need to go to principals as it lives in the appendix.
- Arbiter/League Scheduler (Jason): VNN will not pull info from tournaments or scrimmages. When you go in to add a kingco tournament, tourney directors will have to move teams forward in VNN. League scheduler for commissioners: previously something you had to pay for. We can have it turned on for league for free. Once commissioner drops the schedule, then the commissioner cannot do anything else. Jason will send us a write up.

Motion approved to do own schedules for fall with the exception of sub varsity that needs to be sorted out (i.e. JV/C football and C soccer), and then move toward schedules by commissioners for winter and spring.

Do not use co-ed for team titles. Lance/Jason/Dan will send out list of how teams are titled.

Summary: Fall schedule IN now, DO NOT put any winter schedule in until August after we meet again. schedule non-leagues for winter to not be published.

- Schedules to be approved
 - GBB, BBB, WR, GY: Yonni and Jason worked on and finalized the wrestling/gymnastics matrix and dovetailed it with basketball. Will continue with wrestling traveling partners, gymnastics may have a wed or thurs dates, which is only dependent on official availability. Looking to schedule girls meets. Motion approved for wrestling/gymnastics matrix. Juanita hosting Kingco tourney.
 - 3A basketball has been approved already.
 - 2A basketball schedule- motion approved.
 - Spring schedules: Sent to classification to approve as 1st reading. Will approve with larger body in August.
- Arbiter/WOA: lots of questions about accounting issues, having to pay up front, and then getting nothing from WOA. Needs to be addressed.
- 2021-2022 Meeting Schedule: discussed hybrid (classification, large group, off week, so every 3 weeks we meet as large group) and zoom for classification meeting if necessary. With some hook-in meetings around holidays to account for long time away. Also discussed twice per month, one meeting of these designated to classification for the most of meeting. Motion to do hybrid model. APPROVED for 21-22. Meet in person for large group, classification is optional. Large group at BSD.
- **Kingco coaches meeting:** League meeting Aug 19 with fall commissioner sport to choose either location or zoom/teams. LW can host any meetings for fall coaches meeting, start at 7 pm. Commissioners can decide where to have meeting and what format? Lori will send out where kingco meetings will be located.
